1.) United Kingdom: Special rules for British citizens from January 19<sup>th</sup>, 2007:

“**British citizens**” are obliged to visa if the following notes are included in their travel documents:

- *British Overseas Territories Citizens (who do not have the right of abode in the United Kingdom)*

- *British Overseas Citizens*

- *British Subjects (who do not have the right of abode in the United Kingdom)*

- *British Protected Persons*

**Visa-free:**

- *British Nationals (Overseas)*

*British Overseas Territories Citizens* or *British Subjects* who own residence permit in the United Kingdom are qualified as British citizen – and as citizen of the European Union at the same time – for that reason they are exempted from visa obligation.

2.) European Community: members of the Delegation of the Committee of EC are allowed to enter to the Republic of Hungary visa-free with the mentioned travel documents, and they are allowed to stay there for the period of their service visa-free.

3.) Croatia: citizens of Croatia are allowed to enter to Hungary with ID only if the purpose of their stay is not employment or getting income.

4.) Sweden: Swedish citizens are allowed to travel to Hungary with new plastic identity card (which was issued after October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2005 and includes data of the owner's citizenship).
